Sorting instructions **

Food waste and leftovers container





- Soiled packaging
- Pizza boxes
- Food paper wrapping
- Coffee and crisps bags
- Wax candles
- Vacuum cleaner bags
- Ash and grill charcoal
- Cat litter
- Nappies, cotton wool and sanitary towels
- Disposable wash cloths and cotton wool buds
- Gift wrapping and ribbon
- Cleansing wipes and used paper handkerchiefs

REMEMBER to put all leftover waste in a sealed bag.





- Fruit, vegetables and bouquets
- Meat and bones
- · Fish and shellfish
- Eggshells and nut shells
- Used kitchen roll, coffee grinds and filters, tea bags
- Pasta, rice and noodles
- Left-over cake and bread
- Cheese and milk/dairy products
- Paper that has been used to wipe up oil/grease

REMEMBER to put all leftover waste in bags. Close with a knot.



Recycling container





- Plastic bottles, e.g. shampoo bottles
- Trays from meat, fruit and vegetables
- Plastic plant pots
- Plastic lids
- Plastic tubs (e.g. from yoghurt)
- Plastic bags
- Clean soft plastic film
- Bubble wrap

REMEMBER that all plastic from food packaging must be clean and dry. Waste can be placed loose into the container or in a bag which is then placed into the container.





- Milk cartons
- Juice cartons

REMEMBER to empty and rinse them.





- Food tins
- Beer and soft drink cans
- Foil trays and metal lids
- Bottle caps
- Clean aluminium foil
- Tea light retainers

REMEMBER that tins and other food packaging must be clean (not contaminated with food residue) and dry. Put everything loose into the container.







- Newspapers, magazines and advertising
- Letters and envelopes
- Writing and drawing paper

REMEMBER that paper must be clean and dry. Remove plastic wrappers from magazines before putting them (loose) in the container.

- Wine bottles
- Glass bottles
- Jam jars
- Pickle jars
- Drinks glasses



REMEMBER that glass packaging must not contain leftover food.

Continue using the recycling islands for cardboard Find your nearest recycling island using our "Affaldsportal" app





- · Cardboard boxes
- Kitchen roll and toilet paper tubes
- Clean cardboard packaging
- Egg box

REMEMBER that cardboard must be clean and dry.



Hazardous waste

Hazardous waste must still be deposited at your recycling centre.
